HOW TO BOOK

To join us for this incredible experience, simply fill in the enclosed registration form and send it back to us as soon as possible.

Don't forget to include a Cheque for the amount of \$460.00 payable to the Lightning Ridge Bush Safari. Don't forget if you wish to order any shirts or meals to include payment for them.

Please return registrations to us by the 1st August so that we can order the shirts. We will then forward you a detailed program approximately 3 weeks prior to the Safari.

COSTS

There is a registration fee of **\$460** per vehicle. **NOT** per person! Also you will need to set aside funds for:

- * All food & fuel en route.
(meal packages available)
- * Any personal requirements.
- * Parts used for any vehicle repairs.

CANCELLATION POLICY

No refunds of fees will be made within 2 weeks prior to the Safari departure.

UHF or CB RADIOS

It is very strongly recommended (but not essential) that all vehicles carry some form of 2-way radio communication (UHF). This way, reports of road conditions, breakdowns, and general messages may be made. **(Please Note That The Police Vehicles And Committee will be on UHF Only)** If you wish to hire or purchase CB or UHF radio, we suggest you should really only consider UHF, as CB is not that common. Mobile phone services are not consistent.

Souvenir Shirts

Please indicate on the registration form whether or not you wish to order a souvenir collared shirt and your size. The cost is \$45.00 each. (sorry for the price rise)

Shirts are only available by pre-ordering by the 1st August!

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

As the name implies, we be travelling in outback regions of Australia with limited mechanical facilities and spare parts available at the outback centres. Although our mechanic is available to help with repairs he is not a travelling spare parts shop. We will forward you a suggested list of spare parts requirements and the obligation is yours to ensure that your car and/or trailer are mechanically sound. Due to the nature of the roads we encounter.

Only OFF ROAD TRAILERS.

ROADS

Roads on the Safari are suitable for conventional or 4WD vehicles. Vehicles with low clearance (sedans) are not recommended, as we will be traveling on dirt roads. If you do wish to bring your 2 wheel drive vehicle it is recommended that it is fitted with underbody protection, particularly the fuel tank as some roads are quite stony. There is a briefing each morning on road conditions and relevant information for the day. The Safari is not a race, but a leisurely outback trip.
